The Chevrolet Silverado, and its mechanically identical cousin the GMC Sierra, are a series of full-size and heavy-duty pickup trucks manufactured by General Motors and introduced in 1998 as the successor to the long-running Chevrolet C/K line. The Silverado name was taken from a trim level previously used on its predecessor, the Chevrolet C/K pickup truck from 1975 through 1998. Reintroduced for the 2015 model year, the Chevrolet Colorado continues to find a steady stream of buyers. Accordingly, Chevrolet has limited the updates for 2019 to few minor trim and tech items.
