

Download Autofocus Vs Manual Focus

NIKON D700 @ 420mm, ISO 500, 1/2000, f/5.6. In this article, I will teach you everything I know about focus modes on modern DSLRs. Since autofocus functionality depends on what camera type and model you are using, I obviously cannot go over all available AF modes, so I will only go through a couple of examples. I shoot a lot of soccer games with a Nikon D300 and a 200-400 f/4. I am regularly asked how I set up the camera for best auto-focus. Here's what I do: Hi – Great post. I just got the Reikan pro and tried it out. Like you, my 24-105 was all over the place, especially on the 5D Mark III, which, by the way, requires you to input the micro adjustment numbers during the automatic processing – apparently Canon disabled or left out the ability to set the micro adjustment numbers in the software SDK that Reikan uses to control the camera. This post describes an autofocus test chart I've developed, why I think it's better than others I've seen, and how to use it to test the autofocus of your camera and lens: If you suspect that your modern SLR or SLR lens has autofocus problems, you can use a chart like the one offered on this page to perform some tests.
