The owner's manual for each vehicle provides the recommended mileage intervals for service. Typical recommendations generally range from 30,000 to 60,000 miles. Some manufacturers build transmissions which claim to have lifetime fluid, though when reading the fine print it's usually decided that "lifetime" means about 100,000 miles. Answers. In a manual you will be replacing clutches and that gets expensive, you are better off having an automatic where most of them last at least 140,000 if you change the fluid and filter at the 50,000 intervals.
