Books for Children, Teens and Adults Ages 0-3. This is How We Became a Family: An Adoption Story: By Wayne Willis (Author) An adoption story for children of all ages. It tells of a couple who long for a child, of a pregnant young woman who is not ready to be a mother, and of the events that bring them together for a happy ending.
